1. Minutes from September 30, 2015 were approved (6 votes in favor).
2. Discussion for new course proposal: AAV356 / Motion Graphics
  - a. Professor Chung Chak of The Department of Art and Art History proposed the addition of the new course AAV356 / Motion Graphics. The course has been taught previously as a special topics course.
  - b. The committee discussed the issue of potential repetition across courses offered in IMM and AAV, specifically related to motion graphics.
  - c. Members of the committee introduced a larger issue of overlapping curriculum and limitations in student enrollment in courses outside of their majors (i.e., Art and Art History students having a hard time getting into IMM courses) that might warrant a separate discussion among relevant faculty and/or the Curriculum Committee.
  - d. The committee opted to have Professor Chak refine his syllabus and proposal to reflect clear course objectives and evaluations that accurately portray the most recent version of this course (which he noted had been adjusted since his submission of this proposal), as well as to better reflect distinguishing components of this course and courses of similar topic in IMM.
  - e. Next Step: Professor Chung will revise his proposal and resubmit the updated documents at a later point.
